WHAT IS NEMBRIC

The first NEMBRIC (National Emergency Medicine Board Review of India Course) was organized in 2016 in collaboration with National Board of Examinations as a Board Review Course in Emergency Medicine and replaced the ongoing INDUSEM-ACEE-EMPACT (Emergency Medicine Practices and Advanced Clinical Therapeutics). It is the only existing Board Review Course in Emergency Medicine in India which now has completed seven years.

The fourth board review program shall cover the essential curriculum for training of Postgraduates in Emergency Medicine. NEMBRIC, an intense teaching programme, will be taken by leading faculty from international and national institutions. This yearly program has been designed for those who specialize or undergoing training in the area of Emergency Medicine, Medicine, Anesthesia, Family medicine as well as General Practitioners who practice in rural settings, nursing homes, small hospitals. It will also be very useful for other Specialists who are looking to refresh their expertise in Emergency Medicine. This yearly program shall be very useful to the Faculty involved in training postgraduates of Emergency Medicine.
